

A message from Elizabeth Pierce regarding the closure of the Duke Energy Children's Museum



Dear Members,

I am writing to share with you an update on construction news. As I shared last Friday, we learned that repairs as part of the restoration of Union Terminal will have an impact within the Duke Energy Children's Museum.

We have now made the difficult decision to close the Duke Energy Children's Museum through Spring 2018 to allow those repairs to be made. It has been our intention to keep the Duke Energy Children's Museum open as much as possible during this process, however, the construction activity is more extensive than anticipated and will disrupt public access to large areas of the Children's Museum. As portions of the Children's Museum become an active construction site, we made the decision to close this space.

While we know this is disappointing to you right now, this is necessary for securing the long-term future of Union Terminal.

We deeply value your support as Members during this time. Thank you for your continued support as we restore this iconic National Historic Landmark

Due to this closure, we are automatically extending your Membership 6 months.
